	Parent group: Apparel sale announcement. We made \$242.82 in the Panda percentage night. We were able to sell items during the Kinder-1 st grade winter performance we made \$400. All profits from the mariachi performance went back to the mariachi it was a total of \$600.00 to help them with the Mariachi conference in April. We are in the process of buying school school-wide movie license that will cost \$610.00 for the year. Events we have been supporting include Planting trees with Mr. Steve on January 4 th and January 15 th a total of 8 trees were planted. 	Principal response: Thank you for your comment I have been working along with Ms. Arnquist and our team to figure out a way that we can make all of our programs maintain the integrity of what we say they are and make them even better so that families like yourself can benefit from it. As part of our enrichment courses, fifth graders will start having PE this quarter so we will get at least our fifth graders as well I'm working with Mr. Mealing PE teacher to figure out ways for fourth graders and make a rotation. We are looking to see if we can do anything with third grade and below, I personally think every grade and every student should get PE once a week, art is right there, I'm looking into different possibilities we don't have an allocation for our teacher but I'm looking at ways and ideas.
